EVENT MINIMUMS

In order to organize regattas and training, a minimum of 4 and no more than 10 sailors for each event is needed. For double handed, this means two boats.

For logistical planning reasons, the deadline to commit to each event is 30 days prior to that event. For example, for the March break training camp (March 13-17), we require a commitment to attend by February 11th.

This is to be sure we meet the minimum amount of sailors to proceed with the event.

There will be a 20% late fee for registering after the 30-day deadline (provided there is still space available).

For each individual event, please make sure to register through the event website as well.

EVENT COSTS

The cost for each event will be determined by the number of sailors registered and will cover all coaching costs. When registering, you must provide a non-refundable deposit, which will be put towards the final cost for each event (including training days at local clubs). For example: if the final cost for an event is \$1200, you will only pay the difference of \$800.

Cancellation decisions will be made and communicated no less than 3 weeks prior to the event with a full refund (less 5% for Checklick fees incurred) if the minimum number of sailors is not met to run the event.

This gives us 1 week after the cut off day to cancel the event should we not reach min. amount of sailors

For reference: 2023 event cost = Average cost was \$150/day CAD per sailor

Parents/Sailors are responsible for covering their own:

- Flights
- Accommodations
- Event registration fees
- Food
- Other personal expenses

TEAM LEADER

BOAT TRANSPORTATION

There are a limited number of available spots for boats to be transported to Florida for winter training. See below for pricing.

All boats are required to have own individual insurance coverage. PCYC is not responsible for personal boats.

Key Dates:

- The cut-off date for trailer registration will be **November 3**rd.
- The trailer loading day will be November 10th, when we will have a staff member available for assistance.
- LIMITED SPACE AVAILABLE. Spots will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis.

We have three trailers going to Miami. The laser trailer has space for six boats, the 29er trailer has space for 2 boats, and the multi-boat trailer has space for nine optis, one laser and two 29er/C420. A summary of available spaces per boat type is in the table below.

Adding additional trailers to open up spots may be considered if demand warrants. Please indicate your interest as soon as possible.

Only those that have paid for a spot on the trailer will be permitted to load their boat onto the trailer on November 10th.

If you would like to bring your boat down to Miami and train elsewhere, we can accommodate provided there is still space remaining on the trailer after November 3rd. Priority will be given to those training with PCYC and attending events with PCYC.

Refunds for trailer cancellations

- Full refund less 5% if cancelled on or before November 3rd.
- 50% refund will be given if cancelled between November 4th and November 9th.
- No refund will be provided for cancellations on or after November 10 (loading day).

TRANSPORTATION VOLUNTEERS
