EVENT MINIMUMS

In order to organize regattas and training, a minimum of 4 and no more than 10 sailors for each event is needed. For double handed, this means two boats.

For logistical planning reasons, the deadline to commit to each event is 30 days prior to that event. For example, for the March break training camp (March 10-16), we require a commitment to attend by February 10th.

This is to have costs finalized ahead of time and be sure we meet the minimum number of sailors to proceed with the event

There will be a 30% late fee for registering after the 30 day deadline (provided there is still space available).

For each individual event, please make sure to register through the event website as well.

EVENT COSTS

The cost for each event will be determined by the number of sailors registered and will cover all coaching costs. When registering, you must provide a non-refundable deposit, which will be put towards the final cost for each event (including training days at local clubs). For example: if the final cost for an event ends up being \$1200, you will only pay the difference of \$800. Member discount pricing will apply.

Cancellation decision will be made and communicated no less than 3 weeks prior to the event with a full refund (less 3.5% for Checklick fees incurred) if the minimum number of sailors is not met to run the event.

This gives us 1 week after the cut off day to cancel the event should we not reach min. amount of sailors

For reference: 2024 event cost = Approx. \$180/day CAD per sailor

Parents/Sailors are responsible for covering their own:

- Flights
- Accommodations
- Event registration fees
- Food
- Other personal expenses

TEAM LEADER

If there is any parent that would like to volunteer as a team leader that will be helpful for us. <u>Registration will be first come first basis.</u> PCYC senior and associate members will be receiving a discount from listed price, which they will be able to apply to each event registration.

BOAT TRANSPORTATION

There are a limited number of available spots available to be transported to Florida for winter training. There is a minimum price per boat for a spot on the trailer; this will be paid once you confirm your registration for your trailer spot. This cost covers the round trip of the trailer, which will leave mid-December (or earlier) and arrive back late March. Prices will not be set until we confirm numbers, however a deposit calculated based on projected costs will be required to hold your spot on the trailer. The difference between the deposit price and full price will be processed by Checklick on November 2nd. See below for projected pricing (assumes full trailers).

All boats are required to have own individual insurance coverage. PCYC is not responsible for personal boats.

Key Dates:

- The cut-off date for trailer registration will be October 30th.
- The trailer loading day will be **November 5**th, where we will have a staff member available for assistance.
 - LIMITED SPACE AVAILABLE. Spots will be assigned on a first come, first serve basis.

TRANSPORTATION VOLUNTEERS
