Responsibilities

- Provide technical support and be available for team meetings prior to the event dates
- Coach training days and regatta days at the selected championship
- Liaise between the team, team leader, parents, and Organizing Authority
- Provide other support as deemed necessary by CODA

Qualifications

- A minimum of three years of coaching experience
- A minimum of Sail Canada Competition Development (Level 3) coaching qualification, or equivalent international certification.
- Sail Canada Learning Facilitator qualification or other high-level certification (or equivalent international certification) is considered an asset.
- Experience coaching at international level regattas is considered an asset.

- Demonstrate Sail Canada/Sport Canada coach registration in good standing (or international equivalent)
- Demonstrate completion of <u>Sport Canada Safe Sport</u> training (register and complete training online)
- Provide an up-to-date background check (vulnerable sector and criminal)

Terms of Employment

- Coaches will be required to obtain medical treatment and repatriation insurance covering the entire period of the stay in the host country.
- Coaches will be remunerated for daily and travel expenses such as:
 - Food
 - Transportation (airfare and ground transportation)
 - Communications equipment
 - o Registration fees, etc.
- The coach's daily wage will be decided based on the CODA payscale and will be commensurate with the coach's experience
